All Balls sold by Pickleball Stuff conform to the USAPA description of ball specifications. Although Tournament Directors may only choose from a list of approved balls on the USAPA list for USAPA sanctioned tournaments, all the above listed balls are suitable for playing pickleball recreationally.

The JUGS Bulldog is a durable polyball, claimed by the manufacturer to be "The toughest polyball ever made." This ball is mid-weight and mid-hardness of the three brands of balls - harder than the Cosom Balls and softer than the Seamless DURA Balls. It is suitable for all court surfaces and indoor or outdoor play. It's good for those who like a fast action ball, but is easier to slow down for those finesse shots and dinks.

The Cosom Fun Ball is the softest and lightest of the three brands. It is easy for beginners to learn the game with this ball. It is also more conducive to playing finesse shots and developing a wider variety of shots. Point plays will be slightly longer and more interesting. It is a safer ball because of the relative softness. Although this ball can be used indoors or outdoors, it may be more subject to windy conditions.

The Seamless DURA Ball is the hardest of the three brands. Pickleball played with this brand will result in a faster paced game with shorter point plays. If you like playing a game of power hitting, this is the ball for you. This ball is also suitable for indoor or outdoor play. Because this ball is heavier, it is less subject to windy conditions outdoors.
